Phenomenon is not just a fest, but a meeting ground for passion, talent and tradition.

So what are you waiting for? The spotlight beckons to you!

If you are looking to have the experience of a lifetime, Phenomenon 2025 is the place for you.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The dress code must be strictly followed. Shorts, skirts, sleeveless/crop tops, and ripped jeans are prohibited. Only trousers and sleeved shirts are allowed.
- Security personnel have the right to inspect bags and belongings at the entry points.
- Entry will be permitted only to those with valid passes or coupons.
- Entry bands must be worn at all times. If found without a band, he/she will be escorted off the campus. Bands will be removed once you leave the school premises, and no re-entry will be allowed.
- Entry will be allowed only to those who are carrying their school/college/government photo ID cards.
- Public displays of affection, of any kind, are strictly prohibited.
- All participants must carry a consent form signed by their parents.

The following items are strictly prohibited:

- Outside food and drinks. (Water dispensers will be available.)
- Disposable or reusable bottles.
- Inflammable substances, including but not limited to perfumes, hand sanitisers, and aerosols.
- Illegal and restricted items such as alcohol, tobacco, condoms, marijuana, any kind of drug, etc.
- Laser pointers, Vapes, Cigarettes, High heels, Strollers, Pets and Glass.
- Any sort of weaponry or sharp and harmful objects (e.g., nail cutters, combs, Swiss army knives, scissors, knives, box cutters, blades, pens, pencils, etc.).
- Toy replicas of guns or objects to throw/shoot, Pepper spray, Power banks, Makeup and accessories, and Helmets.
- In case of emergencies, follow the evacuation protocols as directed by the security team. First-aid stations will be available on-site for minor injuries or health issues.

Policy on confiscated items:

- Items of value are strictly not permitted inside the school campus during the fest. This includes jewellery, large sums of money, and any other valuable personal belongings.
- Any items of high value will be confiscated by the security personnel at the entrance and be disposed of. Students and visitors will not be permitted entry otherwise. Kindly cooperate with the checking process.
- Confiscated items will not be returned under any circumstances. The school will not be held responsible for the loss, damage, or misplacement of such items.

Anti-harassment policies:

- All attendees, event staff, and volunteers must be respected at all times.
- Any form of harassment, discrimination, or inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Instructions from the event staff and security team must be followed at all times.
- Any violations of these rules will result in immediate action by the organizing committee or security personnel.

**Please note that those who fail to follow these guidelines will be escorted off the campus.
If necessary, legal actions will be taken against those who misbehave.**

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- To register, visit sjbhs.edu.in/phenomenon/
- All prices are inclusive of GST (if applicable).
- Institutional delegation: An institution does not need to send a team to every event. Participation in at least 12 events is required for institution registration.
- Only one person from each institutional delegation must fill the registration form.
- Clear list of all members of an institutional delegation is required for registration (irrespective of the number of delegations).
- 'Individual' participants need not be from the same institution.
- Registrations open on the 8th of November, 2025.
- There will be no Best Institution Award.
- General Passes for each day will be available for purchase on campus on that day and payment will only be accepted via online modes (UPI, Credit/Debit cards etc.).
- General Passes are non-transferrable.
- Registration for an event includes entry to the campus, concert/artist performance access and event participation on the day of the event only. All events except "The Director's Cut" are one-day events only. For entry into the campus on the other day, a General Pass will have to be purchased.
- Tickets for the comedy show and the fashion show will have to be purchased separately and are not included in the General Pass.
- No refunds will be processed.
- Registration for multiple events is permitted. Please check the schedule to ensure that there are no clashes.

EVENTS

- On-spot registrations will be open if the cap for that particular event has not been met.
- All participants are expected to be present at their respective event's venue 1 hour before the commencement of the event. Students from Grade 8 to 1st-year degree are allowed to participate only in the events that mention the above.
- INSTITUTIONAL TEAMS are considered as teams representing a particular school/college and are automatically considered for the entire bouquet of INSTITUTIONAL EVENTS.
- INDIVIDUAL registrations are permitted.
- The participants will be divided into 2 categories (only for the events that mention the above)
 - Category 1 – Grades 8 to 10
 - Category 2 – Grade 11 to 2nd Semester of 1st year degree
- A valid ID proof from schools/colleges/government must be shown at the time of registration.
- All events are judged on common and unbiased grounds.
- Any sort of vulgarity, obscenity, teasing, or mockery in any form and at any point in time is prohibited and will result in immediate disqualification at the discretion of the Teacher-in-charge and/or the judges. Misconduct on campus by the students will lead to their expulsion. Reports may be made to the respective school or college management if deemed necessary.
- Failure to conform to the time limit for events will lead to negative marking/disqualification at the discretion of the judges.
- All music and media required for events must be submitted at the console/relevant location, under intimation to the Venue and Event-in-charge, 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. The music in .mp3 format, and the media in recognised formats, must be submitted in labelled pen drives.
- Participants are required to bring their own devices, props, data connection and any other items that are deemed necessary by the concerned event provided that they don't fall under the restricted category of items.

Participants are required to adhere to and abide by all the instructions given by the Event Heads.

MYTHOS

Group Theatre Event

Where passion meets performance — this theatre demands collaboration, courage, and creative brilliance. From spontaneous performances to thought-provoking scripts, teams must push boundaries and explore every shade of human emotion. Whether it is comedy, tragedy, or chaos, only the most convincing storytellers will steal the spotlight

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a team event (four - six member per group)
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Teams may bring their own costumes, props, and background music. Permission for props must be taken in advance from the respective Event Heads.
- Use of live music, body percussion, or a cappella is encouraged.
- Pre-recorded audio must be provided on a USB or phone in compatible format before the event.
- Use of fire, water, or hazardous substances on stage is strictly prohibited.
- The act can be original, adapted, or inspired from literature, real life, or social issues.
- Any cases of obscenity, profanity, or religious/political defamation will lead to disqualification.

- Vulgarity is prohibited and will be heavily penalized.
- There will be multiple rounds with elimination.
- The decision of the judges and organisers is final and binding.

DECRYPTIA

Treasure Hunt Event

Where logic ends, curiosity begins. Every clue shatters preformed notions, every hint leaves you perplexed. Nothing is as it seems, and the obvious will mislead you. Be prepared to think twisted, act quicker and decode the chaos. And in this battle between intellect and instinct, speed is as essential as your wit... will you find what eludes others?

Rules and regulations:

- This is a trio event (three members per group).
- Students from grades 8 to 1st year degree are allowed to participate.
- There will be multiple rounds with elimination.
- Participants must carry basic stationery.
- External assistance and AI-generated content are strictly prohibited.
- Use of the Internet will be restricted throughout the event.
- Further instructions will be provided at the venue.

DISC-O-FEVER

Disc Battle Event

A high-voltage DJ disc battle where beats clash, crowds roar, and turntables ignite. Spin harder, mix smarter, and drop the track that wins the night.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Each contestant is required to make a mix of around 10 minutes. This mix must be the contestant's own mix.
- Each mix will be judged based on the style of mixing, originality, perfection of transitions, etc.
- The mix has to be dance-music based. There is no limitation on the sub-genre.
- Each contestant has to submit the mix on Day 1 of the fest by 12 p.m.
- Contestants are required to submit the mix on a labelled pen drive. The top 4 will be chosen by the evening of Day 1, and the results will be put up at the earliest.
- The top 4 will get to play on the main stage on Day 2 during the 'DANCE MUSIC FESTIVAL' for a maximum of 10 minutes.
- Contenders wishing to make use of any other sort of equipment must carry it with them and notify the Event Heads at the earliest.

BOX CRICKET

Cricket Event

Many competitors, One champion. With every ball a risk and every shot a make-or-break moment, Box Cricket is not for the faint of heart. Do you have what it takes?

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a Penta event (5 members per group, inclusive of 1 substitute).
- This event is open to students from grades 11 to 1st year degree.
- The teams must come in sporting attire.
- Players are to bring their own bats (plastic bats are not allowed).
- The event will be in a direct knockout format.
- More information relating to this event will be provided after registration.

ZENITH

Science Event

Pursue. Perceive. Prevail.

A collaboration where the minds ascend beyond horizons. Zenith beckons bold thinkers into a phenomenal realm, where curiosity reigns, coordination illuminates the darkness, and every moment sparks wonder. The skies of knowledge await to be explored, for this is where brilliance reaches its highest point.

Rules and regulations:

- This is a duo event.
- Electronic devices are discouraged.
- The event is open to students from grades 9 to 1st year degree.
- Adequate knowledge and understanding of all science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths) is required.
- There will be multiple rounds with eliminations.

ALETHIA

Journalism Event

“Uncover. Reveal. Report.”

Everyone’s got a story, but only a few can tell it right. Hunt the truth, construct your narrative, and break headlines before anyone else does. The press is yours, make it loud.

Rules and Regulations:

- Team Event (2 members per team).
- This event is open to students from Grades 8 to 1st Year Degree.
- Participants must carry their own devices (phones/ laptops) with a working internet connection.
- Charging points will not be available.
- There will be multiple rounds with elimination, each testing a different journalism skill.
- Plagiarism or use of AI will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Further details will be revealed on the day of the event.

BATTLE OF THE BANDS

Music event

The amps are buzzing, the drums are set, and the stage is ready for the loudest showdown of the season. Battle of the Bands is back - and it’s bigger and bolder this year! This is your moment to plug in and show us what you’ve got. So, grab your gear, take a deep breath and make the stage YOURS.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a team event (5-2 members per group).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- All bands are required to have at least one vocalist.
- No backing tracks will be allowed.
- Use of pre-recorded material is prohibited.
- Misuse of any equipment including microphones, wires and drums will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Team members may be drawn from different schools and colleges.
- If all the team members are from the same school or college, then only one team will be permitted.
- Instruments will not be provided except for a standard drum kit.
- Timing: 5+3 minutes

PSYCHEPULSE

Psychology Event

Explore the labyrinthine corridors of the human brain, where the distinction between truth and deceit start to blur. Decipher the encrypted codes and the mysterious influence of the cerebrum, and delve into the depths of the shadows that shape our deepest selves, right under the ticking clock, where the mysteries of human behaviour await discovery.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a duo event (two members per group).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Use of any technology is prohibited.
- There will be multiple rounds with eliminations.

VEND

Commerce Event

From pitching unique ideas to negotiating deals and trading in unpredictable markets, participants will experience the real hustle of the business world in VEND, the fast-paced commerce event where creativity meets strategy. Each round will test the participants' marketing skills, financial judgement, and power to persuade. Think smart, negotiate sharply and sell. Do you have what it takes to conquer the market?

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a trio event (three members per group).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Each team will be required to carry at least one laptop.
- No internet connection will be provided.
- The use of AI is not permitted.
- There will be multiple rounds with elimination.

PRINT-MY-SOUL

Poster-making Event

PrintMySoul is more than a poster-making competition. From crafting wordless stories to merging random elements in perfect consonance, each challenge pushes you to translate pathos into design. The goal isn't perfection, but creating something louder than words.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to first year degree.
- Plagiarism of any kind is prohibited.
- Participants must bring their own laptops or tablets.
- Participants must abide by the theme of every round, which will be disclosed on the day of the event.
- Materials allowed: any kind of paints (except spray paints), colour pencils, sketch pens (crayons are not allowed).

RAP RUMBLE

Music event

Face off your opponents in battle of lyrical wit and electrifying skill! Although their knees may be weak or their arms heavy, participants are expected to write with originality and keep their flow all while showcasing their individuality in freestyling ability and stage presence. This show is not simply one of words, but one of quick-thinking skills and musical prowess.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- Two categories:
 - Category 1 : Grades 8 to 10
 - Category 2 - Grades 11 to 1st year degree
- Vulgarity of any kind will result in immediate disqualification.
- There will be multiple rounds with eliminations.
- Participants must follow preparation and performance time limits.
- Plagiarism or pre-written verses not allowed unless instructed.
- Props must be approved before use.
- Beats will be provided by the organizing team.
- The order of performance is decided by means of chits.
- Further instructions will be given after registrations.

WESTERN VOCAL DUET

Music event

Music is the language of the soul. Grab a duet partner, write your harmonies and display your vocal talents at PHENOMENON 2025 - the stage is yours!

Rules and Regulations:

- It is a duo event (two members per group).
- This event will be held in 2 categories:
- Category 1 - grades 8 to 10.
- Category 2 - grades 11 to 1st year degree.
- Theme: 90's R&B.
- Participants will be given 3+1 minutes to perform (including set up).
- Each team will have to submit their sound track/karaoke (if required) before their performance, through a pen drive ONLY.
- Teams must ensure that their audio files are named clearly.
- The participants can play any one instrument while singing. If not, ONLY one accompaniment is allowed per team.
- No instruments will be provided by the school.
- No backing vocals allowed.
- Songs containing explicit or inappropriate lyrics are strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disqualification.

THE DIRECTOR'S CUT

Filmmaking Event

"If it can be written, or thought, it can be filmed."

Stanley Kubrick

Capture the furrows of your vision in this enticing opportunity.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a trio event (three members per group).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to first year degree.
- Participants must bring a working camera or phone, and a laptop with video-editing software installed.
- Participants may use the permitted areas of the campus to shoot their films, but are not allowed to leave the campus.
- Drones are not permitted.
- There will be multiple rounds with elimination.
- Participants must have ready access to the internet to upload their films to Google Drive. Alternatively, pen drives may be used.

WESTERN VOCAL SOLO

Music event

Music, an outburst of the soul - The stage is set, the lights are ready and all eyes are on YOU. Take the stage boldly and showcase your skills with melodious vocals and astonishing talent!

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- This event will be held in two categories:
- Category 1- Grades 8 to 10
- Category 2- Grades 11 to 1st Year Degree
- Theme: Classic Revival – A Tribute to Retro Hits (no vulgarity permitted).
- Performances not matching the theme may have points deducted.
- No instruments will be provided; participants must plan an instrument or track if accompaniment is required.
- An accompanist will be allowed, but no extra points will be awarded for accompaniment.
- All music and media required for events must be submitted at the console 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. The music in .mp3 format and the media in recognised formats must be submitted in labeled pen drives.
- No extra vocals are allowed on the backing track.
- Timings: 3+1 minutes.

REVERIE

Fashion Show

“People will stare. Make it worth their while.” Whether they choose intricate detailing or take a minimalistic approach, participants are expected to display their artistry and originality in their work, while keeping the designs UNIQUE and stylish. Walk that runway with pride!

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a team event (8-12 members per group).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Timings: 5+2 minutes.
- There will be two rounds in this event.
- Open registrations may be permitted if the cap for the number of teams is not met. (The team members may be drawn from different schools and colleges).
- If all the team members are from one particular school or college, then only one team will be permitted in such a situation.
- The theme for this year's fashion show is The Harmony of Emotion and Art. Each team will be assigned a unique art piece. They must interpret and depict the emotion expressed in the piece.
- A team name must be submitted beforehand. Participants are strictly prohibited from using their institutional name.
- All the participants must carry their own attire and props.

- Dress code restrictions will be conveyed to the teams after the registrations close.
- Violations pertaining to the dress code will lead to disqualification or negative marking.
- Vulgarity is strongly prohibited. Any form of obscenity will lead to the immediate disqualification of the team.
- The dimensions of the ramp will be disclosed after the registrations close.

WESTERN DANCE GROUP

Dance Event

Get ready to bring the heat to the stage - Clash of Crews is where the best dance teams go head-to-head, showcasing their rhythm and creativity. From hip-hop to jazz, from street to contemporary, every performance lights up the stage with style and energy. Step up and own the spotlight!

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a team event (4-8 members per team).
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st year degree.
- Timing: 3+1 minutes.
- Costumes and props are the responsibility of the participating team. They must be appropriate.
- Use of flammable or hazardous items on stage is strictly prohibited.

- Dance movements must be age-appropriate and culturally respectful, with no element of vulgarity.
- The music track must be free of profanity, inappropriate language or vulgar content.
- All music and media required for events must be submitted at the console 45 minutes prior to the start of the event. The music in .mp3 format and the media in recognised formats, must be submitted in pen drives that are labelled.

WESTERN DANCE SOLO

Dance Event

The Western Dance Solo invites performers to bring their unique style, technique and emotion to life, whichever style of dance it may be. It's about confidence, rhythm and the art of movement - it speaks for itself. May the best dancer win!

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to 1st Year Degree.
- Participants will have 2+1 minutes to perform their prepared dance routine using their chosen song.
- Any vulgar choreography or inappropriate music will result in disqualification.
- Participants will be allowed to use props brought by them.
- All choreography must be original.

- Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- All music and media required for the event must be submitted at the console 45 minutes before the commencement of the event. The music in **.mp3** format and the media in recognized formats, must be submitted in labelled pen drives.
- There will be multiple rounds to test the creativity and originality of the participants.

PERSONALITY

Flagship Event

At our flagship personality event, every individual's charm is probed for authenticity. With unpredictable twists in every round, participants must rouse their wit, sensibility, spontaneity and good humour to deal their own winning hand.

As the competition intensifies, only one will seize the title of Mr or Ms Phenomenon 2025.

Rules and Regulations:

- This is a solo event.
- This event is open to students from grades 8 to first year degree.
- The use of profanity will lead to immediate disqualification.
- There will be multiple rounds with eliminations.
- Further details regarding the event will be communicated after registrations.

- This is a quad event (four members per group, including one substitute).
- There are separate categories for boys and girls.
- Girls : Grades 8 to 12
- Boys : Grades 11 to 1st year degree
- Teams must come in sporting attire, and everyone must have a uniform jersey for easier identification.
- FIBA rules and regulations must be followed.
- All the matches will be live. The tournament will be conducted in league cum knockout format.
- The decision of the referee is final.

LIGHTS-OUT

- Further details concerning the rounds will be specified on the day of the event on the spot.

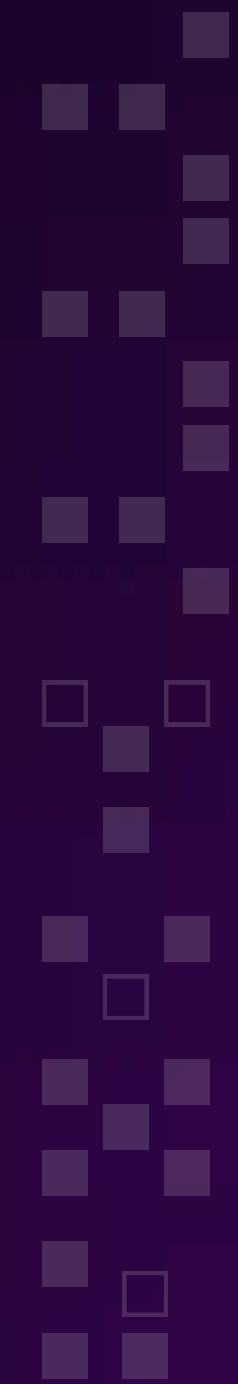
